

Information on Virtual Classroom Programs for the 2021-22 School Year (Effective September 1, 2021)

The *Jamestown Rediscovery* education team offers virtual classroom programs focusing on the archaeology and history of Jamestown. Educators may choose from a list of available topics and presentation formats below. Combination programs include both a Virtual Site Tour and a PowerPoint lesson. All programs can be tailored for grade 3 through college as well as mixed groups, such as scouts. Adult groups interested in online programs should visit our Lifelong Learning page.

Program Options

PowerPoint Lessons (60 minutes)

Discovering James Fort Fee: \$75

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian to learn about the history of the first successful English colony in the Americas and how archaeology has reshaped our understanding of this important site.

The Powhatan and the English (1607-1622) Fee: \$75

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian to discuss the varying relationships between the Powhatan Indians and the English colonists beginning in 1607 and throughout the 17th century.

The First Africans in Virginia (1619-1699) Fee: \$75

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian to learn about the arrival of the first Africans in Virginia in 1619 and the legacies that have endured over 400 years. Program includes a discussion of the archaeology at the Angela site, where one of the first enslaved Africans at Jamestown lived and worked.

Virtual Site Tour (60 minutes)

Virtual Site Tour Fee: \$100

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian for a virtual tour around the James Fort site. Weather conditions may affect the program.

Combination Programs (90 minutes, which can be split into two shorter programs if needed)

Virtual Site Tour & Discovering James Fort Fee: \$150

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian for a virtual tour around the James Fort site and a PowerPoint lesson on how archaeology has reshaped our understanding of this important site.

Virtual Site Tour & The Powhatan and the English Fee: \$150

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian for a virtual tour around the James Fort site and a PowerPoint lesson discussing the varying relationships between the Powhatan Indians and the English colonists beginning in 1607 and throughout the 17th century.

Virtual Site Tour & The First Africans Fee: \$150

Join a *Jamestown Rediscovery* historian for a virtual tour around the Jamestown town site and a PowerPoint lesson on the arrival of the first Africans in Virginia in 1619.

Living History (60 minutes)

Interview with Anas Todkill Fee: \$200

Join Anas Todkill, a comrade of John Smith, for an interactive, first-person account of life at Jamestown in the early 17th century.

Online Meeting Platform Information

The *Jamestown Rediscovery* education team will set up a program on Zoom. Teachers may choose to host a virtual classroom program though their school's online platform, if preferred (see below for additional information).

Hosting through Jamestown Rediscovery's Zoom Account

Our education team will set up your virtual program on Zoom, which can be accessed by up to 500 individually connected participants. Our education team will email the zoom link to the teacher or program contact 2-3 days ahead of time.

Hosting through a School's Online Platform

In order to ensure the best experience, the virtual meeting system must have screen sharing capabilities. If the system offers chat messaging, students may use this feature to ask questions during the Q&A periods. Schools preferring to use their own platform will be responsible for any costs associated with the use of the online meeting services. Teachers may include as many students as they would like in a virtual classroom program as long as they are not exceeding the participant limits of the platform. All meeting links/IDs should be emailed to *Jamestown Rediscovery* staff at least 30 minutes prior to the program's start time. *Please note that Google Classroom is often only accessible to those within a school's domain account, so this platform is not recommended for hosting the virtual classroom program unless it can be configured for outside presenters to connect.*

During the Program

Students are asked to mute their microphones until the start of Q&A. During the Q&A, students must wait to be called upon by their instructors or the *Jamestown Rediscovery* educator. Students may also use the virtual "raise hand" option available on selected platforms or submit questions via the chat function.

Requesting a Virtual Classroom Program

Requests for programs are accepted starting on the first of each month, two months prior to the desired month of the program (see the schedule below). Early booking is encouraged as slots can fill up quickly. Someone from our education team will contact you within 3 business days of submitting a request to complete your reservation, and program dates and times cannot be guaranteed until we have reached out to you.

Please provide a little information about the group, including the school or group name, the students' grade level, and your role. Our programs are recommended for students 3rd grade and up. For mixed-age groups, like scouts, please indicate the range of ages, so that we can best tailor the program to the learning levels represented.

When would you like to schedule your virtual classroom program

Please feel free to list specific date(s) and times although we cannot guarantee availability until a member of our educational team has contacted you. If your schedule is more flexible, list approximately when you would like to schedule a virtual program, such as the month or a preferred day of the week.

Number of students?

Indicate approximately how many students are expected. The number of students who may participate is not limited as long as they can be accommodated on the virtual meeting platform.

Online Platform

Please indicate whether you would prefer for *Jamestown Rediscovery* to set up the program through Zoom or to use your school's own online platform. If you will be using your school's system, please indicate what the platform is.

Fees
